Also known as, wildfires, bushfires are fires that burn in forest especially the ones that spread rapidly. They are extremely dangerous. They can destroy properties and lives. Bushfires can start naturally or from human actions either accidentally or deliberately. Some of the human actions that cause bushfires are hunting fires, campfires discarded cigarettes. For example, during the dry season and hunting periods in many rural areas across Africa, villagers often set fire to kill either to trap animals out or to clear the land and prepare it for the coming farming activities. Bushfires affect fauna and flora by causing deforestation and acceleration of desertification.

Bushfires are therefore very dangerous and can lead to terrible consequences to people and environment. People living in rural areas must adopt new techniques of hunting and farming in order to preserve forests and animals.
